This year we are back at the Four Star Royal Park Hotel in Rochester, Michigan for a wonderful evening of dining, dancing and socializing.

Dancers and spectators are invited to join us for dinner at 6pm to enjoy a sumptuous 4 star dinner and receive premium seating! Dinner for MSO members is \$35 and \$40 for non-members.

After hosting over 300 last year at this event, we have expanded our dinner dance to the entire Ballroom with seating for 450. There are lots of great seats, but we recommend that you purchase your dinner tickets early for the best seating.

Also, new this year we are featuring online purchase of your tickets and the ability to reserve whole tables of 10 for ten days while your dinner companions buy their tickets to join you. Tickets go on sale May 1, 2008.

If you are a dance competitor, this event is one of the most elegant and inexpensive dance events you will ever attend.

We have three highly qualified judges back again this year: Glenn Clark, Candice McKenzie and Tera Vitale. They bring judging expertise to the floor that includes ballroom, swing and country western.

The atmosphere is very friendly and the dance categories diverse! You may compete at any of three different skill levels and at various age groups.

The cost of entering the DanceSport competition is \$5 per person. The \$5 entry fee covers ALL your dance entries. Your \$5 fee includes admission to the ballroom, but does not include dinner. Also, if you plan to compete in medal events you must become a member of the MSO for \$25. Included in that membership are two entries for Medal events and three Ribbon event entries.

We will be dancing on a 30 x 60 foot dance floor. Strict tempo music is provided by Bob Northrop of DJ PLAYS (Bob along with Melissa Muha are the organizers of the DanceSport competition).

A limited number of Spectator tickets at \$10 each will be available. Spectators may enter the ballroom at 6:45 pm for non-assigned seating.
